



Exxon's Espejo Federal Com 3H well achieved an average IP24 of 2,234 BOE/d in Jun-18






Select PE backed companies within a 10-mile radius of the marketed position

24 drilling permits have been approved in the vicinity of the package during the last 6 months





Marketed acreage



Leasing Activity


Marketed acreage is in a concentrated leasing location

Oxy acquired 12 leases at an average ~\$13,005/Acre in the vicinity of the marketed acreage in Dec-2018





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
Bone Spring and Wolfcamp well performance by operator
